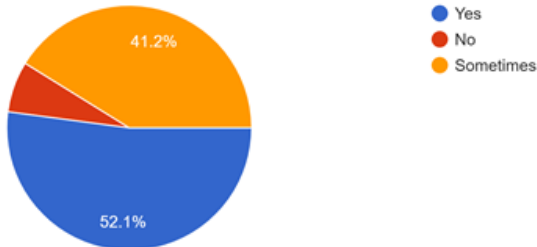
Home Learning Review 2022/23



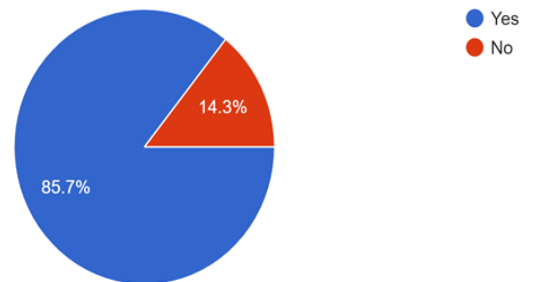

What our learners said...

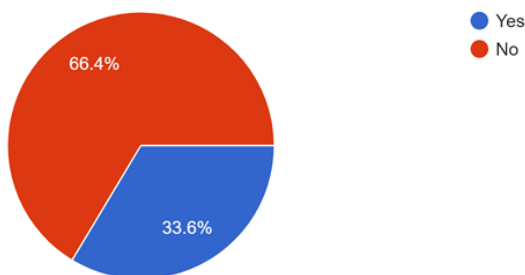
Do you enjoy looking at the learning lowdown?
119 responses



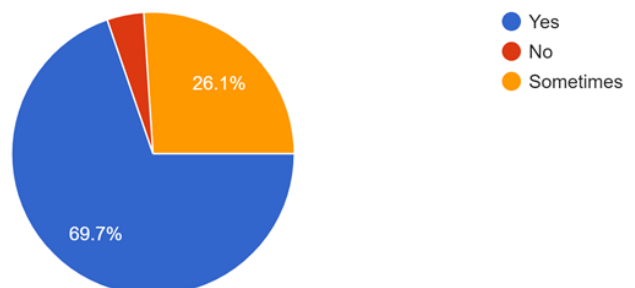
Do you like to complete spelling tasks?

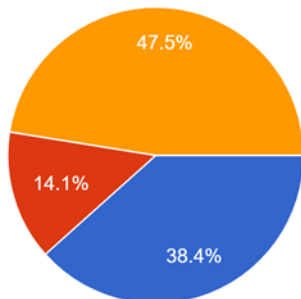


Do you talk to someone at home about your home learning every week?

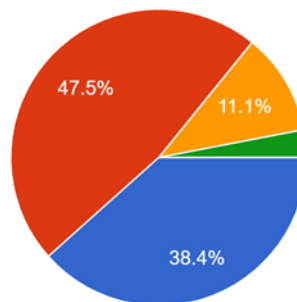

How often did you engage with the Learning Lowdown with your child?

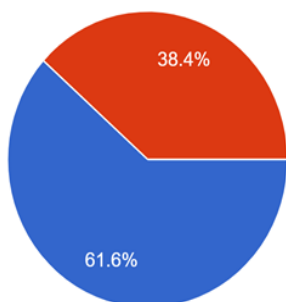

Do you feel this amount of home learning is suitable for your child?

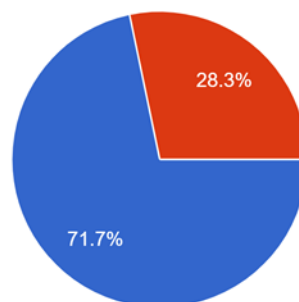

Would you like more written tasks that your child submits to the teacher?

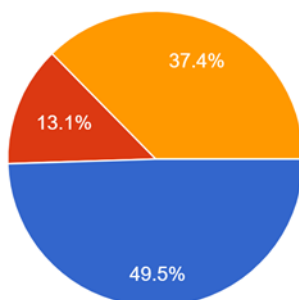

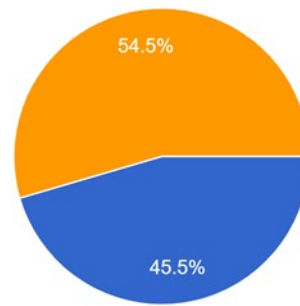

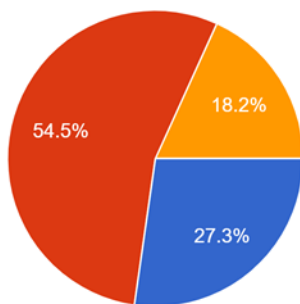

How often did learners engage with the Learning Lowdown on Google Classroom?

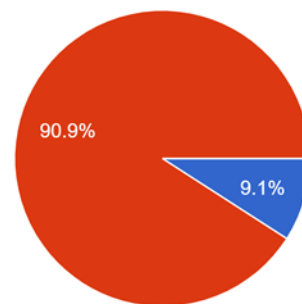

Some comments from our stakeholders -

"It would be good to get different types of activities sometimes and not always just spelling words and Sum-dog".

(Learner comment)

"I feel both my children would really benefit from a short written task each week that supported their learning".

(Parent/carer comment).

The learning lowdown provides a stimulus for conversation and reminds my child what they have been learning rather than the usual "I can't remember".

I like the idea of talking homework tasks. I do like the idea of Learning Lowdown but only if they are useful for parents as they do take some time to prepare. I like that they keep families using Google Classroom too.

(Staff comment)

We asked...

You said...

We did!

Do you enjoy looking at the learning lowdown?

93.3% of parents/carers said yes or sometimes.
85.9% of learners said yes or sometimes.
100% of staff said yes or sometimes.

We are keeping the Learning Lowdown and this will be shared every Friday on Google Classroom.

The Learning Lowdown helps promote learning conversations, set targets and share what learning is taking place in the class.

Would you like more spelling or written tasks each week?

71.7% of parents/carers said yes.
66.4% of learners said no.
90.9% of staff said no.

The last slide of the Learning Lowdown will change slightly due to the mix in responses.

Please note, only complete what you can each week. We understand family life can be very busy but these tasks are there for the respondents who wanted more written/set tasks.

We also asked for other comments at the end of the survey.

Many comments focused on lack of consistency - "It seems that there is an inconsistent approach to homework".

Therefore, we aim to produce a clear and concise Home Learning Policy that states what should be expected at each stage in the school. This will be issued in due course. The last slide of the Learning Lowdown will be consistent across the school to begin.
